## Items Required During O-Week (20-26 August 2017)

The items below are in addition to those items identified in the "Checklist of What to Bring When Moving In" document.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input type="checkbox"/> Two (2) pairs of running shoes</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> (1) pair black safety-toe work boots (steel-toe or composite)</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Six (6) white <u>crew-neck</u> (V-neck not permitted) t-shirts</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Six (6) pairs of white athletic socks (crew length)</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Four (4) pairs of white athletic socks (ankle or no-show)</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Six (6) pairs of underwear (white or light gray)<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>o White or light gray color is strongly recommended especially with the Summer White uniform</li></ul></li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Three (3) pairs of dark blue jeans (no cargo pockets)</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> One (1) plain maroon polo (preferably nylon/quick-dry; no design; no pattern; TAMU logo is permitted)</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> One (1) pair khaki or tan cargo pants (available at most Army/Navy surplus stores)</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Plain black or blue swim trunks (Male Cadets)<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>o No design; no patterns</li><li>o For wear during swim qualification</li></ul></li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Plain black or blue one-piece bathing suit (Female Cadets)<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>o No design; no patterns</li><li>o For wear during swim qualification</li></ul></li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Sun block (SPF 30 or greater) and mosquito repellent/bug spray</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Personal first-aid kit and athlete's foot powder/spray/cream</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Prescription medication, over-the-counter medication (i.e., pain reliever, anti-diarrheal, etc.) and personal items (i.e., prescription eyewear, contact lenses, contact lens solution, etc.)</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input type="checkbox"/> Health insurance information and emergency contact information</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Black Fine Point Sharpie permanent marker</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Bedding, bath towels, toiletries, toilet paper (reference "Checklist of What to Bring When Moving In")</li></ul> <p><b>FEMALE CADETS ARE ENCOURAGED TO ALSO BRING THE FOLLOWING:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Sports/activity bra (primarily for wear during PT)</li><li>• Bobby pins, barrettes, and/or elastic bands that match your hair color</li><li>• Natural make-up (no bright or vibrant colors for eyeshadow and/or lipstick)</li></ul> <p><b>NOTE REGARDING EARRINGS:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Males will not be permitted to wear earrings</li><li>• Females are limited to one earring per ear (i.e., gold/silver stud or small loop)</li></ul> <p><b>NOTE REGARDING GROOMING STANDARDS:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All Fish (male and female) will be instructed on proper grooming standards of the Corps of Cadets pursuant to the Corps Operations Manual<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>o All Fish will report with in their natural hair color</li><li>o All Fish will report with their natural nail color<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Nail polish and artificial nails are not permitted during O-Week</li></ul></li><li>o All male Fish will receive the standard Fish cut at the start of O-Week (the cost of the haircut is \$10.00)</li></ul></li></ul> <p><b>NOTE REGARDING CASH ON HAND, CREDIT CARD, OR DEBIT CARD:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All Cadets are strongly encouraged to have at least \$150 of cash on hand, a credit card, and/or debit card for incidentals and last minute purchases</li><li>• An ATM is located next to the Mess Deck of the Texas A&amp;M Maritime Academy Hall as well as at the Sea Aggie Center and in the breeze way between the Seibel Building and the Mary Moody Northern Student Center</li></ul>
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
