Confirm Participation	May 1	All Gateway students register for & attend the 1-day, July 1st New Student Conference. tamug.edu/nsc
Apply for Financial Aid	ASAP	Complete the FAFSA to be awarded Financial Aid. Please note you must complete the 2018-19 FAFSA for Summer aid and the 2019-20 FAFSA for Fall/Spring aid. tamug.edu/finaid
Housing	May 1	Pay the \$75 application fee to apply for Summer II & Fall housing; no deposit required. Residence Life will send roommate assignments 2 weeks prior to Gateway; note you will likely receive your Fall/Spring housing assignment prior to receiving your Gateway housing assignment. Visit their website for provided/prohibited items, housing location, what to bring, and to submit housing inquires. tamug.edu/reslife
TSI and Math Placement Exam	May 15	Visit the TSI website to check if your SAT/ACT scores satisfy TSI standards. Students not meeting Standards must take the TSI Assessment. tamug.edu/slc/testing/tsi.html All Gateway students take the MPE, regardless of SAT/ACT scores or major. MPE scores determine your initial math course. All science (MARB, MARF, MARS, OCRE, OOH) and engineering (MARE/MARR) complete the MPE during the New Student Conference. All other students (MART, MARA, MAST, MPPC, TCCD, & MELP) must take the MPE online prior to summer course registration. tamug.edu/slc/testing/mpe.html

Complete Tuition Rate Selection	June 3	Remove this hold by selecting the Fixed Tuition Rate. Selection is final. If you have questions, please consult with Financial Services before selecting. Summer II Course Registration	June 17	Your Gateway courses will be selected for you using your declared major, assessment scores, academic strengths, & course availability. Please ensure that you have taken care of all the above steps on time so you can be registered for coursework promptly. By June 18, you can log onto HOWDY to view your course schedule. 6 credit hours are needed for full time status. If you need to speak with an advisor about changes to your schedule, please contact the Seibel Learning Center by June 22 at (409) 741-4343.
