The Biden-Harris Administration Unveiled the first-ever strategy to advance environmental justice for communities that rely on the ocean and marine resources through the following three goals:

1. Embed Ocean Justice in Federal Activities (better incorporating equity into funding processes)
2. Develop a Diverse, Equitable, Inclusive, and Accessible Federal Ocean Workforce
3. Enhance Ocean Justice through Education, Data, and Knowledge
