Established in 2021 by Madelaine G. Heaven and Allen R. Vorholt

The Paul Heaven Memorial Foundation Excellence Award supports a full-time graduate student pursuing a degree in the Department of Marine Biology at Texas A&M University at Galveston. Paul's daughter, Madeleine Heaven '18, and her husband, LTJG Allen Vorholt '18, established the scholarship to honor his memory.
