Capt. Greg Tylawsky, class of 84, graduated from Texas A&M University at Galveston with a bachelor's degree in marine transportation. Greg grew up <u>in awe</u> of tanker ships and dreamed of a career in the maritime industry where he could work on a ship and travel the world. When it came time to apply for college, Greg was rejected by all of the maritime academies except for Texas A&M. The other academies claimed that they took <u>in-state</u> applicants first; but as a resident of Florida, Greg was warmly welcomed by A&M Galveston.

Greg says that all of the chapters in his life go right back to the Texas A&M Maritime Academy, and that Texas A&M opened up his world and gave him his dream, a great career at sea.

Greg and his wife Sally established their first endowed

scholarship in 2018 as a planned gift. After over 13 years as a San Francisco Bar Pilot, Greg has retired starting a maritime consulting practice, and felt inspired to establish this new endowed scholarship as a current gift.
