

Regents' Scholars Agreement

Program Requirements - Fall 2018 and Spring 2019 Terms

Welcome Regents' Scholars! The Regents' Scholars Scholarship, originating from Texas A&M University – College Station (TAMU), is designed to assist first-generation college students in achieving their educational goals at Texas A&M University. Nine hundred recipients will receive up to \$5,000 per year for up to four years – with the ability to add other scholarships.

I, the undersigned student, acknowledge and accept all requirements, rules, conditions, and outcomes as stated for the duration of the Regents' Scholars program at Texas A&M University Galveston Campus (TAMUG). I understand that my receiving the scholarship is also contingent on my commitment to meet each of the following requirements:

- Required Coursework:
 1. All students will be enrolled in the Regents' Scholars Learning Community (LCSE) course:
 - CLEN 289-521, SPTP: ENGR Learning Community
 2. Students that do not pass all sections of the TSI or equivalent exams will be required to take basic courses for those sections. Students may not enroll in a course that requires the skills of the failed section.
- Requirements for continued funding:
 1. Live on campus
 2. Attend Regents' Scholars fall orientation
 3. Participate in the Learning Community course
 4. Attend Regents' Scholars spring celebration
 5. Maintaining eligibility after the first year
 - Complete FASFA and continue to possess financial needs as defined by the Department of Education
 - Meet Satisfactory Academic Progress as defined by TAMU Scholarships & Financial Aid Office and earn 30 hours each academic year:

- I will attend the Fall 2018 orientation and the Spring 2019 celebration unless granted a waiver.
- I will attend ALL classes, including the Regents' Scholars Learning Community course, unless granted a waiver.
- I understand that if I cannot attend the Regents' Scholars Learning Community course (CLEN 289-521) and/or attend the Fall 2018 orientation or the Spring 2019 celebration, I must request a waiver by emailing Ms. Anna Budvitis at atprim2@tamu.edu before the deadline or the function. Waivers will only be granted to students that have credit-bearing courses during learning community sessions and other planned activities, or excused absences as defined by the university.

- I understand that if I am granted a waiver, the accompanying alternative assignment(s) must be completed no later than the Friday of the missed event, by 5pm CT.
