

Master of Maritime Business Administration and Logistics

Expedited Application for Fall 2020

The expedited application process allows graduating Texas A&M University seniors automatic admission to the Master of Maritime Business Administration and Logistics (MML) program, professional (non-thesis) track, if the following criteria are met:

- May 2020 or August 2020 graduate
- Overall undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or above
- Submitted MAAL expedited application
- Submitted Admissions essay

If students do not have a 3.0, their application will be reviewed by the graduate admissions committee for admission consideration.

The Maritime Administration and Logistics degree is a business degree, similar to an MBA, with a specific focus on the maritime industry. The program is available either as a traditional on-campus program or as an online program. The program is approximately 2 years if pursued full-time.

Prerequisite requirements are as follow; if students do not have these prerequisites, they will be required to take them prior to completing more than 6 hours of graduate level coursework.

- Accounting I & II (ACCT 229 & ACCT 230)
- Management Information Systems (MARA 250)
- Economics I (Principles of Economics) (ECON 202)
- Statistical Methods (SCMT 303)
- The Management Process (MARA 363)
