How to Access your Professor's Zoom recordings as student


If your professor shared your online lecture recordings in eCampus or Canvas, and you cannot access it by clicking the recording link please try the following:

OPTION A. If you have the recording link

1. Open Chrome, Safari, or Mozilla, and go to <https://tamu.zoom.us/> and sign in.



2. After logging into our TAMU Zoom website, open a new tab using the same web browser, paste the recording link if you have it, or go to eCampus - <https://ecampus.tamu.edu/> or Canvas - <https://canvas.tamu.edu/> select your course and try to open the recording again, using the recording link.



OPTION B. If your recording link is posted in eCampus or Canvas

1. If your recording is posted in eCampus go to eCampus - <https://ecampus.tamu.edu/>, if it is in Canvas, go to <https://canvas.tamu.edu/>, select your course and try to open the recording, using the recording link.
2. If you see a Zoom “Sign in” page, select “*Sign in with SSO*”.

3. Type “*tamu*” within the Company Domain input, then click “*Continue*”.





4. Login using your TAMU credentials.



5. If the recording requires a password, ask your professor. This password is usually included within the Zoom recording notification that is sent to your professor. Click “**Access Recording**”.



6. At this point you should be able to stream the recording.
