Lowell Anthony Boudreaux has been a faculty member at TAMUG for 17 years and is currently an Instructional Associate Professor of Maritime Administration. He is a Faculty Fellow academic advisor for over 400 graduate and undergraduate students in the Maritime Administration program and has taught twenty-three separate courses with concentrations in Economics, Management and Maritime Administration. A graduate of Lamar University, Beaumont, TX in 1993 in Finance, and Mr. Boudreaux earned his Master's in Business Administration at Lamar University in 1996. He completed a Master's of Maritime Administration and Logistics at Texas A&M, fall 2017.

Lowell serves the University as the Assistant Department Head of the Maritime Business Administration Department charged with coordinating the exchange partnership with Copenhagen Business School, the undergraduate internship program and the Mara minor with the Maritime Transportation students. He is an Administrative Hearing Officer for Student Conduct Proceedings, MARA representative and Chair of the Undergraduate Academic Appeals Committee, MARA representative to the Facility Services Committee, as well as numerous subcommittees. Mr. Boudreaux is an advisor for the campus Student Veterans Association, Aggie Sportsman's Association and the Sea Aggie Shooting Sports Club.

Lowell continues his service externally as a member of the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo World's Championship Bar-B-Que as an Asst. Captain coordinating the Check-in/Information Committee.

Lowell has been recognized for his teaching and service on multiple occasions. He received the Student Led Award for Teaching Excellence, Texas A&M University Galveston, in 2009, 2010, 2011 and the Vice President's Meritorious Service Award, Texas A&M University Galveston, 2008.
