
Campus Wi-Fi

If you need help putting up your poster or anything related to your poster, please visit the poster station located on the main stage. <u>Please be sure your poster is hung before the session starts</u> and immediately removed at the end of your session.

Each judge assigned to you will place a post-it note on your poster before they start judging so that you know who is a judge assigned to you vs. a person visiting your poster. Please expect 3 judges. When you are done, please remove your poster. All posters not removed after your session will be at the lost and found area until Friday by noon. Posters not claimed will be recycled.

Students doing oral presentations can submit their presentation in two ways:


- 1) Email the presentation pathways@tamug.edu February 27 and 28

Presentation files should be labeled with your presentation number. To see your presentation number, please refer to the confirmation email.

At the time of loading your presentation, please check your presentation. All presentations will be given on Windows PCs. We have several presentations so there will not be time to adjust on Friday. Any time you take to load your presentation on Friday will be deducted from your time.

For Oral Presentations: Oral Presentation will be in ASEC 1st Floor (102C and 102D) and 2nd Floor (201, 202, 203, 204, and 205), OCSB (141), and PMEC 151.
