Design, print, write, address, stamp and mail a greeting card to your parents.

Manipulate your digital photographs using Adobe Photoshop in the Texas A&M computer lab.

Produce your own photographic mini portfolio.

Submit your best digital image files for possible publication in *Coast Monthly*, *Galveston Monthly* and the *East End Historical District Newsletter*.

Finish the week with an <u>art exhibit and sale</u> of your best images at the auditorium in CLB 100 on Friday night from 6pm-8:15pm. Family and relatives are invited to attend. There will be brief award ceremony at about 7:55pm.

Nikon D3500 DSLR 24.2 MB camera with an 18-55mm and 70-300mm Nikon VR Lens

Supplies Needed: Please bring your USB cable to attach camera to a computer

- (1) card reader
- (3) rechargeable camera batteries and a charger as we shoot thousands of images
- (2) new memory cards 32 GIG's each
- (1) new flash drive approximately 32 GIG's
