Sea Campus Kids Day Camp Packing List and Information:

- Kids should be prepared to get wet daily.
- They should WEAR PLAY CLOTHES AND OLD LACE-UP TENNIS SHOES which could get wet and/or dirty.
- We recommend that they bring a backpack every day with a change of clothes, shoes, and a beach towel.
- Closed toe shoes are required for field trips, during dissections, & experiments. Sandals can be worn in the classroom after field trips.
- Bug spray and Sunscreen is necessary and should be applied before arriving although we do keep a supply on hand.
- We always have water available for the campers, however, we encourage packing a reusable water bottle each day.
- Bathing suits are permitted as undergarments only. At camp we are not swimming, we are scientists exploring the ocean! Rash guard and quick dry shorts are encouraged as coverings. Don't forget to always pack a spare change of clothes.
- Campers attending all day sessions or back to back morning and afternoon sessions will need to bring their own lunch.











Camp Rules:

- **DROP OFF & PICK UP** All campers must be signed in and out daily by an adult (18 years or older), no camper is allowed to sign him/herself in or out. ID's will be checked and only those listed on the online portal may be permitted for pick up.
- **CAMPER EXPECTATIONS SCK** does not tolerate bullying or harassing in any form (name calling, teasing, unwanted physical contact, etc.). Parents will be notified in the event of a problem, and if the problem persists camper(s) will be not be permitted back.
- **CAMPER BEHAVIOR** does not allow inappropriate behavior (weapon play, play fighting, inappropriate writing or drawing on projects). Parents will be notified if in the event of inappropriate behavior, and if behavior persists camper(s) will not be permitted back.
