Sea Camp Week Long Educator Internship

Sea Camp is a summer residential camp for students ages 10-18 interested in marine biology/science. Interns live with Sea Camp staff and campers in our campus dormitory; assist in daily educational exercises and field trips, evening recreation, and overall well-being of the campers. Camps are week-long sessions and include a wide variety of ocean related curriculum you can bring back to the students in your classroom!



Continuing Education Hours

Upon completion of the internship, educators receive a Certificate of Continuing Professional Education that acknowledges SBEC credit hours of science content earned. The number of hours varies between 7 and 30, depending upon the completed camp program.



Stipends

Dormitory suite and cafeteria meal costs will be paid by Sea Camp or TAG...AND you get the opportunity to learn alongside marine biologists while experiencing all of the amazing marine life the Gulf of Mexico has to offer! Participants are responsible for personal expenses and on campus parking. Additional costs are required for Sea Camp Costa Rica.
